MILAN— Awarded to just four perfumes and one experimental scent project a year, **The Art and Olfaction Awards** are designed to raise public interest and awareness around new developments in independent perfumery. The Awards, established in 2014 by the Institute for Art and Olfaction, are given to outstanding creators in the categories of independent, artisan, and experimental perfume from across the globe, chosen for perfumes released in 2016.

The fourth annual Art and Olfaction Awards events will take place in a public ceremony at the **Silent Green Kulturquartier**—a former crematorium built in 1911 revitalized as an arts venue—in Berlin, Germany on May 6, 2017.

Each A+O Award winner will receive **The Golden Pear**, which continues to cement its status as a prestigious achievement in the perfume world.

As with past years, our panel of esteemed judges includes luminaries from the perfume and art worlds.
